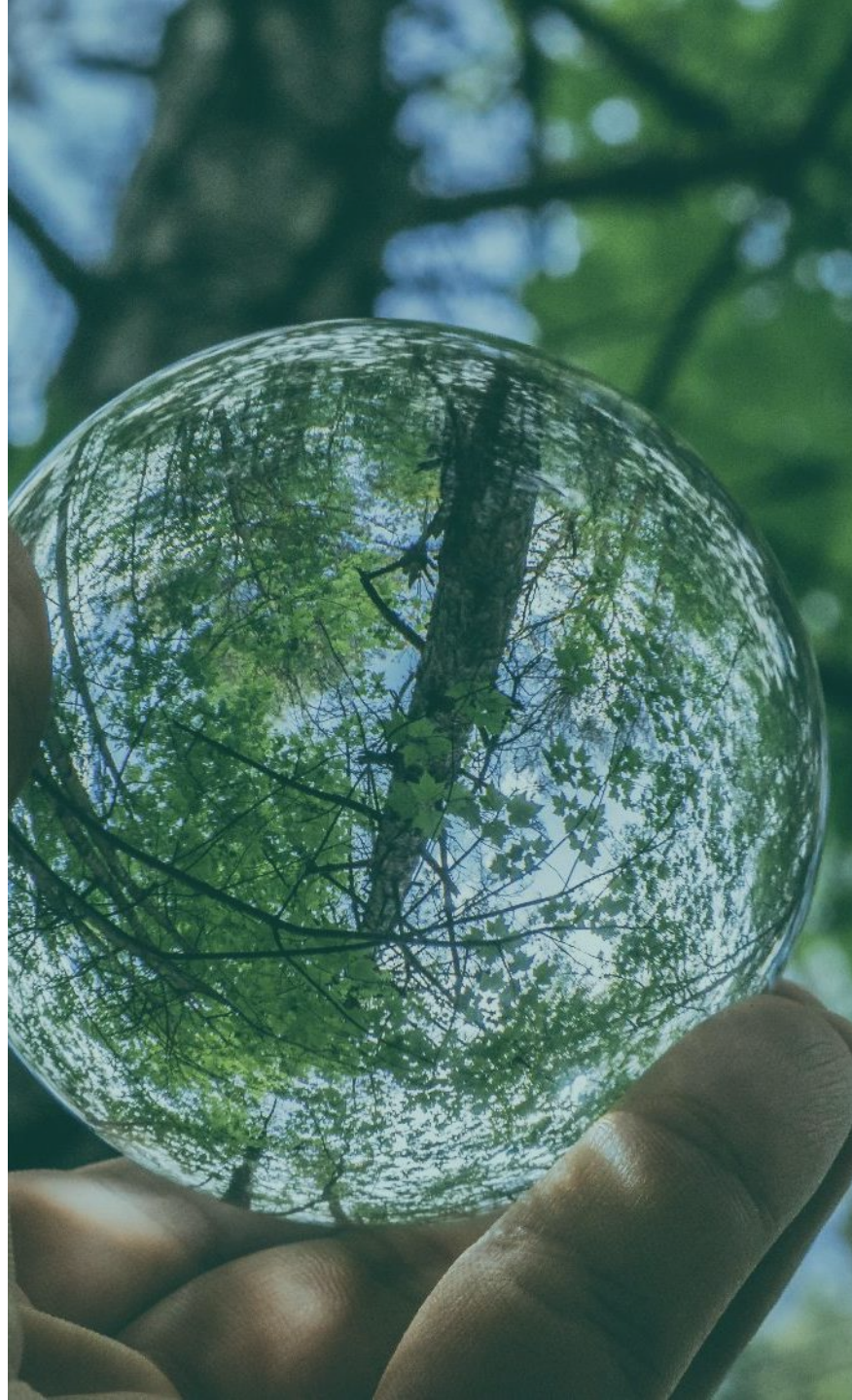




THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION'S PACKAGE IN CIRCULAR ECONOMY HAS ENABLED AN EXPLOSION OF INITIATIVES IN EUROPE

Public funding is the key source of financing for Circular Economy Research & Innovation programmes: **70%** are financed at national level, **18%** at regional and **8%** at European level.

THE CHALLENGES

1

Circular Economy is often not directly addressed or defined in funding programmes – with many focusing on specific impacts, for example Resource Efficiency, which **doesn't consider Circular Economy in a systemic way.**

2

Funding often occurs on a very technical level, looking into specific aspects of the value chain rather than with a systemic focus - this is slowly shifting, but **we need to scale up to increase impact.**

3

The **lack of generic Circular Economy indicators** makes it hard to evaluate the impact of programmes, projects having their specific bottom-up indicators.
