CLOSING THE LOOP ON CIRCULAR ECONOMY FUNDING

CICERONE brings together key stakeholders including programme owners, researchers and businesses to build a platform for joint circular economy funding and programming.







THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION'S PACKAGE IN CIRCULAR ECONOMY HAS ENABLED AN EXPLOSION OF INITIATIVES IN EUROPE

Public funding is the key source of financing for Circular Economy Research & Innovation programmes: **70%** are financed at national level, **18%** at regional and **8%** at European level.

HOWEVER, **NATIONAL STRATEGIES ARE PARTLY** CONTRADICTIVE **THROUGHOUT** EUROPE, **LEADING TO FRAGMENTATION AND LACK OF ALIGNMENT ON PRIORITIES FOR** THE CIRCULAR **ECONOMY**

THE CHALLENGES

1

Circular Economy is often not directly addressed or defined in funding programmes — with many focusing on specific impacts, for example Resource Efficiency, which doesn't consider Circular Economy in a systemic way.

2

Funding often occurs on a very technical level, looking into specific aspects of the value chain rather than with a systemic focus - this is slowly shifting, but we need to scale up to increase impact.



The lack of generic Circular Economy indicators makes it hard to evaluate the impact of programmes, projects having their specific bottom-up indicators.


CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK OF THE SRIA
